

Land users of Jangbi, Wangling, and Phrumzur villages sought contract opportunities for *Tsharzo* (bamboo craft) activities.



Gewog Administration and Dzongkhag Forestry Office explored funds for *Tsharzo* activities to replace the contract system of the land users.



A community group, Monpa Selwai Yoezer Tshogpa, was formed instead and the contract system was stopped. The funds were sourced from UNDP.



The land users were sensitized to group activities by UNDP and Forestry officials. Group bylaws were formulated.



The land users were given hands-on training on bamboo and cane plantations and their product development.



The bamboo and cane plantation program commenced to have a sustainable source of bamboo and cane.
