

# Steps in implementation of PFS

## Phase I: Preparation

- 1. Precondition survey (e.g. assessing local practices and opportunities, identifying stakeholders, etc.)
- 2. Identification and training or refresher training (if previously trained) of master trainers
- 3. Identification and training of facilitators
- 4. General ground work (e.g. awareness-raising meetings, preparation of the curriculum, etc.)
- 5. Establish the PFS

## Phase II: Implementation

- 6. PFS sessions core activities (comparative experimentation, AESA/PESA, group dynamics, special topics, participatory M&E)
- 7. Field days
- 8. Exchange visits
- 9. Graduation

## Phase III: Post graduation

- 10. Follow up of PFS activities
- 11. Establishing PFS networks
- 12. Income generation activities
- 13. Setting of second generation of PFS
